



KANHA KESLI NATIONAL PARK



How to reach - The nearest railway stations are [Jabalpur](#) (150 km) on the West Central Railway.

Kanha consist of grass lands interspersed with patches of dense bamboo and sal forests, crisscrossed by streams to create a perfect ecosystem for the abundant flora and fauna of the region. Located in maikal range of the Satpura hills in the central Indian highlands, Kanha's typical horseshoe-shaped topography make it all the more interesting for views along the rocky ages. Earlier a century, Kanha got its national park status only in 1955 as a part of project tiger and become an official tiger reserve. One can visit here during October to June.
