As you are aware, Government of India is committed to rollout Goods & Services Tax(GST) on 1st July, 2017. Several instructions have been issued in this regard from time to time by Ministry of Railways to Zonal Railways and Production Units, outlining the implementation architecture and guidelines, for ensuring smooth compliance with provisions of GST Act and Rules. MFR/R, RWR/1, MFR/1

2. By now, complexities involved in implementation of GST on Indian Railways must have been well-understood and GST Cells headed by AGM with PCE/CCM/CME/COS and other concerned officers constituted for smooth implementation and compliance. In the remaining few days, till 1st July 2017, it is of utmost importance that all preparatory activities are carried out and monitored so that there is no slack in readiness for 1st July, 2017. Thereafter, monitoring of compliance on collection of all manual invoices, feeding them on computers and sending them to CRIS will be necessary.

3. Adviser/Accounts, Railway Board will get in touch with the FA&CAOs for regular feedback on the status of progress and preparedness. Please ensure that the feedback is given to her without fail.

4. Any issue requiring clarification/resolution from Board may be brought to the Board's notice immediately and such issues must not be allowed to hinder compliance in GST provisions.
