Terms and conditions-

1. Suitable space of 2000sq feet along with space for patient waiting lounge, first aid centre, reception, etc. will be provided by the railways in the divisional railway hospital Bhopal as per guideline of AERB..
2. Only new and unfurnished equipment of latest modality, like 128 slice CT scan and 3 Tesla MRI along with trained manpower are to be installed with permission and approval of railway and district legal authorities. Cost of AMC/CMC of the equipment will be borne by the Service provider. Copies of relevant certificates are to be submitted to the railway authorities..
3. Lock in period will be for 07 years expandable to 10 years on basis of performance.
4. Service provider will have to submit suitable bank guarantee/performance guarantee.
5. The Service provider will shoulder all responsibilities and arrangements not in the scope of railway administration to procure, maintain and operate the equipment at its own cost and has to pay for the water, electricity and space provided by the railways.
6. The Service provider will be allowed to charge the non railway patients on prevailing market rate. However, the charges for the railway patients will be in accordance to CGHS rates. The loads of railway patients generated will be 1-2 per day for CT scan and 01 per day for MRI.
7. The Service provider will have to pay a premium on profit to the railways.
8. The minimum opening Time for the centre will be from 8AM to 6AM. In addition to this, there must be provision of on call investigation and reporting in case of emergency.
9. Service provider should comply to all the statutory regulations and provisions such as AERB, PCPNDT act, Minimum wages act, ESI, EPF, CPA and RTI, etc.
10. A suitable termination clause should be framed by the railways and incorporated in the agreement. Contract may be terminated by either party with three month advance written notice.
11. The Offer on PPP mode will be provided to most promising service provider selected through open tender.
